I'm a full-time children's author based in Cardiff, and since 2018 I've delivered my talks and workshops to more than 22,000 children at schools, libraries and literature festivals worldwide. My events are fun, interactive and designed to demystify the writing process, giving children the confidence to tackle their own stories.

IN-PERSON EVENTS, 2025/26

I offer half-day and full-day events. A half-day consists of up to three one-hour-long sessions, and a full day of up to five one-hour-long sessions. You can choose from any combination of my author talks and creative writing workshops. All my events are suitable for children ages 7-13 (Key Stages 2 and 3) but can be amended for older or younger audiences as required.

Author talk: *Once Upon a Murder*

Learn how my fairytale whodunnits, *The Big Bad Wolf Murder* and *The Beanstalk Murder*, put deadly twists on classic tales. Meet the characters, explore the mysteries and peek behind the scenes to discover how the stories came about.

I then invite my audience to turn detective and re-imagine some favourite fairytales as murder mysteries – choose your victim, nominate a detective, and follow the clues to the solution! The event concludes with a Q&A, book sale and signing session.

Author talk: *Telling Impossible Tales*

How did a bedtime story grow into a bestselling book? I take the audience on a whirlwind tour through the characters, worlds and storylines of *The Train to Impossible Places* trilogy, before inviting them to brainstorm some new adventures.

This is a funny and engaging session that encourages children to think about their own creativity. The event concludes with a Q&A, book sale and signing session.

- Both author talks are highly interactive, and offer children a peek behind the scenes of the creative process, while giving them the confidence and inspiration to develop their own ideas.
- Maximum group size for both talks: 1000 pupils. Duration: 45 – 60 minutes (timings are flexible).

Creative Writing Workshop 1: A Trio of Tricks to Tell Your Tale

We all love stories, but what really makes them tick? And how can we tell our own? This highly interactive workshop explores the three key building blocks of any good story and lets pupils put them into practice straight away, whilst encouraging questions and the sharing of ideas. Perfect for supercharging creative writing skills!

- Maximum group size: 40 pupils. Duration: 45-55 minutes (timings are flexible)
- Children will require a notebook/paper and pen

Creative Writing Workshop 2: Building Better Worlds


All my books involve strange and magical worlds, and this interactive workshop shows children how to create their very own. Together, we'll use arts and crafts to explore the importance of setting in storytelling, as children create illustrated postcards of their newly invented worlds. This is an informal session, ideal for younger age groups, including lower KS2 and upper KS1.

- Maximum group size: 40 pupils. Duration: 45-55 minutes (timings are flexible)
- Children will require coloured pencils or felt tips

Creative writing workshop 3: Making Good Stories Better

"All good writing is rewriting." This workshop demystifies the editing process, with visual examples of my own work, so children can see just how much I get wrong the first time around, and how I go about fixing it. We'll discuss how to give and receive feedback, and the best ways to make their own stories clearer and more effective. This session can be tailored for older age groups, up to KS3 and 4.

- Maximum group size: 40 pupils. Duration: 50-60 minutes
- Children will require a notebook/paper and pen

I offer individual sessions via Zoom, Skype, Microsoft Teams or Google Meet.

Virtual author talks

I offer online versions of both my author talks: *Once Upon a Murder* and *Telling Impossible Tales*, specially tailored for virtual classrooms. They include readings, visual aids and creative writing prompts. Both sessions end with a Q&A, and I can send signed bookplates if the school wishes to arrange a book sale.

- Maximum group size: flexible. Duration: 45 minutes.

Quiz the Author

This is a short session, consisting of a brief introduction to me and one of my books, a reading, and a Q&A session. Perfect if you've chosen one of my books as a class read!

- Maximum group size: flexible. Duration: 25 minutes.
